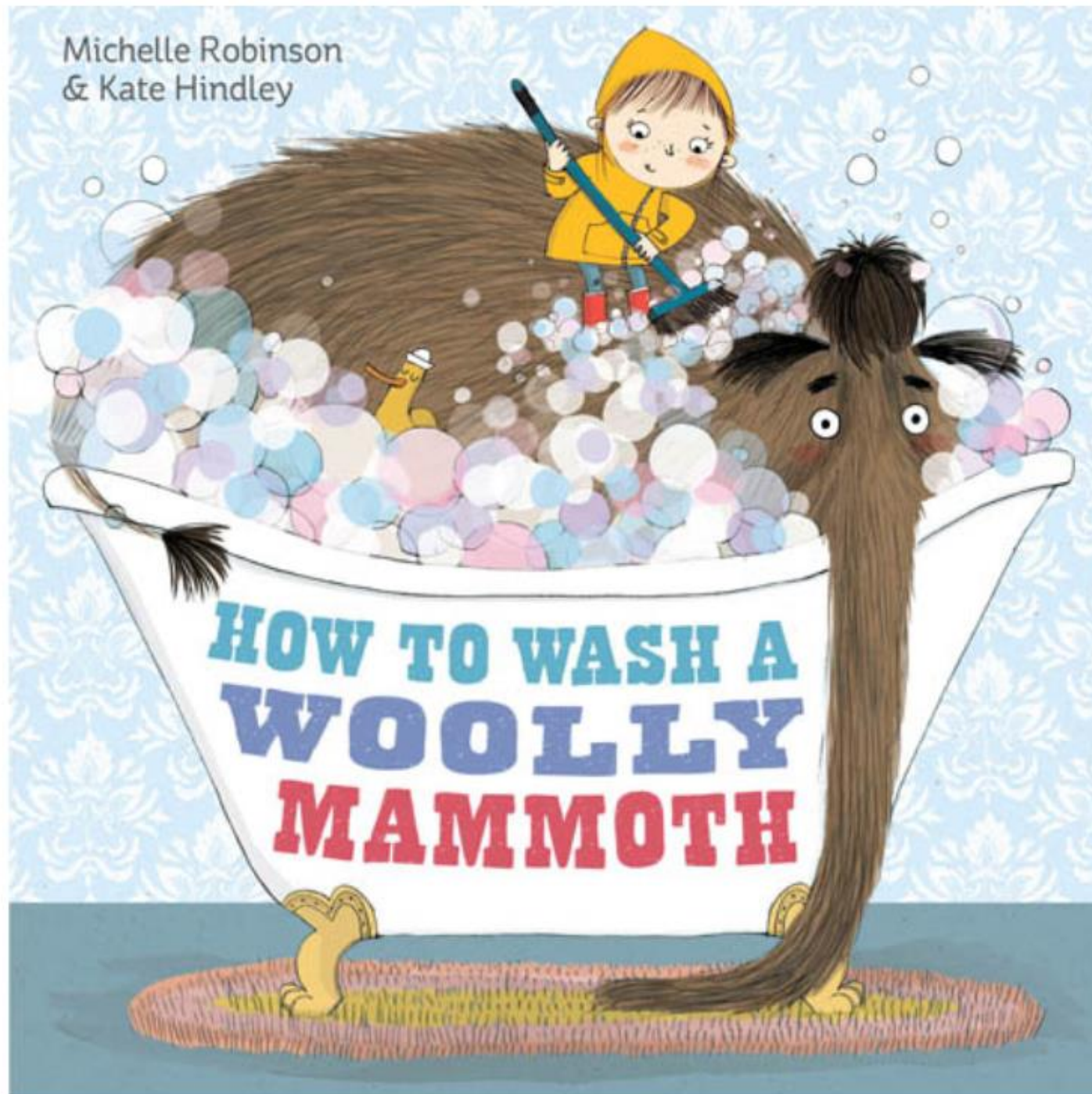


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Does your woolly mammoth need a wash?
